**LEAGUE TENNIS** - Adult league home matches start on Wednesday **28<sup>th</sup> April** and finish (weather permitting) on Thursday **29<sup>th</sup> July**. Starting at 6.30pm there will be five **MONDAY**, fourteen **WEDNESDAY** and six **THURSDAY** matches during this period. The eight **SATURDAY** morning junior matches [from 10am] and six **SATURDAY** mixed league afternoon matches [2pm onwards] start on **8<sup>th</sup> May** and end on **17<sup>th</sup> July**. All matches will use courts 1, 2 & 3 with court 4 needed when there are both junior boys teams playing.
